If there is insufficient stock available an out-of-stock line should be created for remaining quantity after "soft" allocation from the pick face. When there are multiple order lines the variable which marks the line as a SAPP dummy pick is now reset to "N" at the start of processing for each line. This should prevent an issue where the variable was set to "Y" for one order line it was carried over to the next line which could cause code to be skipped leaving the line unallocated. To test this an order should have multiple lines, some for less than a full pallet and some for a number of full pallets. Full pallet picks should create page 1 and dummy part pallet pick should create page 998.
