

1 OBS7000

This is the *NOMS Order Entry* screen (*OBS7000*).



The following fields document the header information for the order:

Field Name	Description
<i>Warehouse</i>	The code and name of the warehouse handling the order (e.g., NFT Default Warehouse Name).
<i>Customer</i>	The code and name of the customer placing the order (e.g., CUSTOMER Mr Customer).
<i>Prison Code</i>	A code identifying a prison, relevant to the NOMS (National Offender Management Service) context.
<i>Location</i>	A specific location related to the order.
<i>Owner Code</i>	The identifier for the owner of the stock (e.g., ROB 001).
<i>Order No</i>	The unique reference number for the order (e.g., ROB00000000000024416).
<i>Entered By</i>	The user ID that entered the order (e.g., SCE).
<i>No Of Units</i>	The total number of units included in the order.
<i>Credit Limit</i>	The maximum credit amount allowed for the customer.
<i>Remaining Credit</i>	The customer's available credit balance.
<i>Balance</i>	The current financial balance on the account.
<i>Order Value</i>	The total monetary value of the order.

1.1 Order Line Grid

This table displays the individual line items of the order:

Field Name	Description
<i>Line</i>	The sequential number of the order line.
<i>Product</i>	The product code for the item (e.g., 00000020).
<i>Description</i>	The full descriptive name of the product (e.g., Bonne Marche Apricot Jam).
<i>Unit Price</i>	The price per unit of the item.
<i>Order Qty</i>	The quantity of the item requested on this line.
<i>Line Value</i>	The calculated monetary value of the order line (Unit Price x Order Qty).
<i>Action Buttons:</i>	



- **Order Completed:** Executes the finalization and completion of the order entry process.
